Apply to timber including new, restored, oiled and some stained or polyurethaned timbers when cosmetic marks contaminate visual aesthetics such as oxidants, watermarks and black spot deposits from: exhaust smut, metal filings, caustic splash (aggregate drive wash), mould spots and environmental grime, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Do this with timbers in shade preferably or overcast day. Direct sun and warmth will evaporate cleaner too quickly.
- Protect painted and surrounding areas and any articles that may get wet. We surrounding areas down with hose water to reduce marking, cleaning uneven run off on these surrounding areas.
- For general cleaning of marks use 50/50 mix with clean water. If marks are particularly bad apply Dryden LiquidTimberClean neat direct to these troubled areas.
- Wearing PVC gloves use a car wash sponge or similar. Apply Dryden LiquidTimberClean from bucket to affected areas. Keep wet and active until marks are acceptable or gone. Continue to wipe runs during the waiting process, keeping wet and active. This may take several hours.
- Once specific marks have gone, wipe timber section all over with diluted Dryden LiquidTimberClean (50/50) to give an even coverage and clean look. Wait for timber to brighten and look all over even. Sponge areas to prevent runs appearing. Wipe in the direction of the boards with soapy sponge keeping active.
- Keep wet and active until timber looks even.
- Wash timbers down with lots of clean water (or water blaster) and sponge until all soapiness has gone, particularly grooves and joints.
- Use old towel or similar to dry timbers of excess water; also remember to dry any water that may have entered surrounding areas.
- Once dry (next day or so) you can coat timbers to protect again.

SAFETY

Do not mix with other chemicals. Avoid all contact with skin (PVC gloves) and eyes (glasses) and keep out of reach of children.

FIRST AID

If you feel unwell: Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.

If Swallowed:

Rinse mouth.

If in Eyes:

Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.

If on Skin/Hair:

Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/ attention. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before re-use.

If Inhaled:

Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.
